To assist in the peer-review process you will need to submit your manuscript as one complete file comprising a title page, abstract, text, reference, tables, figures and figure legends.

Selected manuscripts will be reviewed by selected referees for consideration to be published in the journal special issue. Papers accepted for publication will be prepared in galley proofs and returned to authors for review and corrections.

You will receive the final (Revise, Accept, Reject) decision of the Editor by mail, containing editorial comments.

Manuscript Submission Guidelines

- 1. Submission of a paper implies that it has not been published and is not being considered for publication elsewhere.
- 2. Papers should be written in English or Bahasa Malaysia and should be typed on one side of A4 paper, doubled-spaced throughout, including the reference section, with a 4-cm margin on all-sides. All manuscript pages should be numbered in the following order: combined title-abstract page, body, references, figure captions, figures and tables.
- 3. Papers should be headed by a title, the initial(s) and surname(s) of author(s) and the address of the author(s). The title of the paper should not be a sentence. The title and abstract should be combined on one page. Corresponding author should be indicated in the title-abstract page by providing his/her email address.
- 4. All papers should be summarized in an abstract in English or Bahasa Malaysia consisting of not more than 100 words. Avoid abbreviations, diagrams, and reference to the text. Malaysian author(s) who submit manuscripts in English should, in addition, submit a Bahasa Malaysia abstract. Manuscripts written in Bahasa Malaysia must contain an English title and abstract which are directly translated from the Bahasa Malaysia version. Authors should provide a maximum of five keywords and these should be placed after the abstract.
- 5. References should be cited in the text by an Arabic numeral in superscript. References should be listed in numerical order.
- 6. References to periodicals should include initial(s) and name(s) of author(s), title of the periodical, volume number, page number, and year of publication.
- 7. References to books should include initial(s) and names(s) of author(s), title of the book, name of publisher, place of publication, page number, and year of publication.

8. References to websites should include name(s) of author(s), year published, title of article, name of website, date accessed.

- 10. Figures should be numbered consecutively in Arabic numerals. Figure captions should be listed on a separate sheet of paper. Please submit one figure per page.
- 11. Illustrations submitted should be in separate digital files, **not embedded in text files**. To ensure good quality production, the files should follow these guidelines:
 - resolution of 300 dpi or higher

- sized to fit on page with measurement of $5.0 \text{ in} \times 7.5 \text{ in}$.
- JPEG, TIFF or EPS file format only
