#### **Tables and Figures**

Tables and Figures must appear **within the text** (not at the end of the text). All figures and tables should be numbered with Arabic numerals sequentially, e.g. Table 1, Table 2, Table 3, etc., and they should bear a title (with appropriate upper and lower case letters) which explains their contents. Table headings should be centered above the table. Figure captions should be centered below the figures.

#### **Acknowledgement**

Acknowledgement is optional and should appear before references. The acknowledgement must be short and concise. Sponsorship and financial support acknowledgements should be included here. Acknowledging the contributions of other colleagues who are not included in the authorship of this paper is also added in this section. If no acknowledgement is necessary, this section should not appear in the paper.

#### **References**

References must be listed immediately following the conclusion or summary of the paper or after Acknowledgement. Please use Harvard referencing style, alphabetize by author and for each author list in chronological sequence. List the author's names exactly as written in the source cited. **(Please do NOT list references as footnotes at the end of each page).**
